## NOTIFICATION

**No. TMV/E 554799/43.-** In exercise of powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Assam is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Assam Transport Service Rules, 2003, hereinafter referred to as the principal rules, in the manner hereinafter appearing, namely:—

| Amendment of rule 8          | 2. |      | In the principal Rules, in rule 8, in the first line, in between the words "The" and "academic", the word "minimum" shall be inserted.   |
| Amendment of rule 11         | 3. |      | In the principal Rules, in rule 11, in sub-rule (6),   |
|                              |    | (i)  | in clause (i), in the second line, the words and figures "not completed 50 years of age and" appearing in between the words "who have" and "rendered" shall be deleted;          |
|                              |    | (ii) | in clause (ii), in the second line, the words "who have not completed 50 years of age" appearing in between the words "Transport Officers," and "shall become" shall be deleted. |

Amendment of Schedule II 4. In the principal Rules, in Schedule II, for serial number 2, the following shall be substituted, namely :-

“2.Motor Vehicle Inspector:-

- (i) (a) 10<sup>th</sup> standard pass from any recognized Board; and
- (b) a Diploma (three years course) in Automobile Engineering or Mechanical Engineering awarded by any Institution recognized by the Central or State Government; and
- (c) holding a driving license authorizing to drive motorcycle with gear and light motor vehicles;
- (ii) Candidates with higher educational qualification in Automobile or Mechanical Engineering shall also be eligible for recruitment to the post.”
